- // The course is designed to meet the highest standards of excellence as you develop your intellect and increase your knowledge of God.

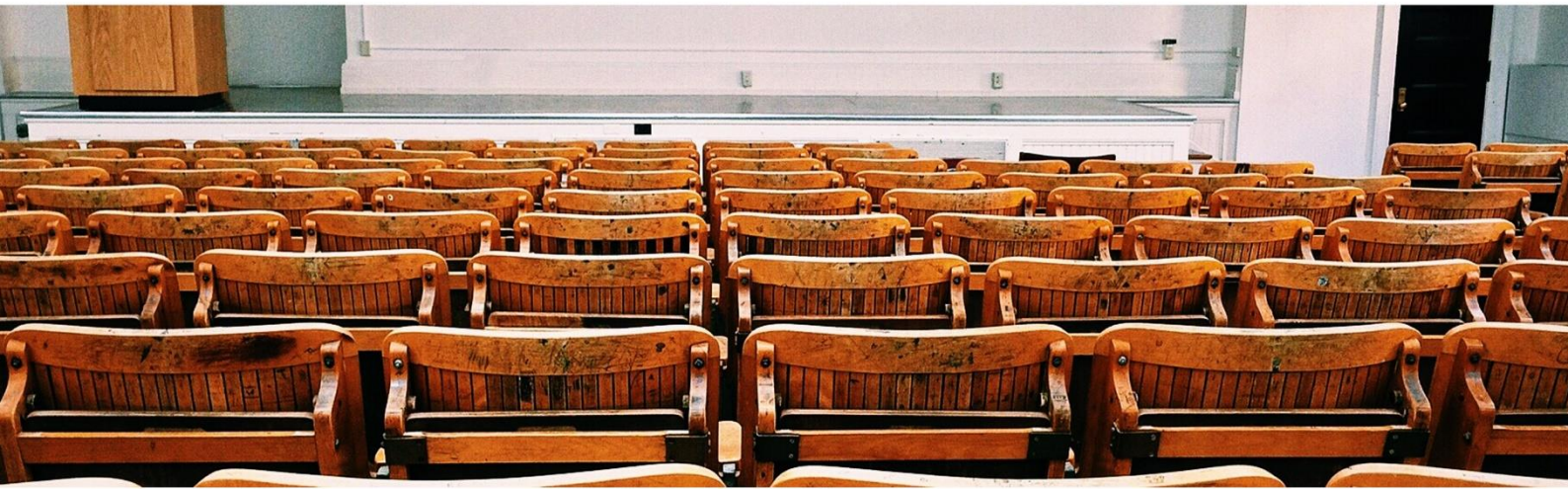
Practical

Typical Timetable ■

King City Leadership College is a one year full time residential course to train and equip men and women for leadership in every sphere of life. The college offers a second year course for those who have specific calling in ministry and will be equipped specifically for Church Planting & evangelism.

This course will be made up of minstry electives, lectures, workshops, chapel services, character and ministry formation groups.

The expected academic requirement is 12th Grade (English medium) on a minimum level or an under graduate degree. 25,000 [PER YEAR]

Rs. 2,085 per month for 12 months

Rs. 25,000 is the course fee for Year 1 students.

This includes:

Tuition Fees - Rs. 17,500

Book Fees - Rs. 7,500

Accommodation will be extra cost.

KCLC will do the best to arrange accommodation for men and women separately. The cost for food & stay is approximately estimated at Rs. 5000 per month. This cost may vary during the time of your admission.

A payment schedule will be discussed with the applicant upon successful acceptance into the college.



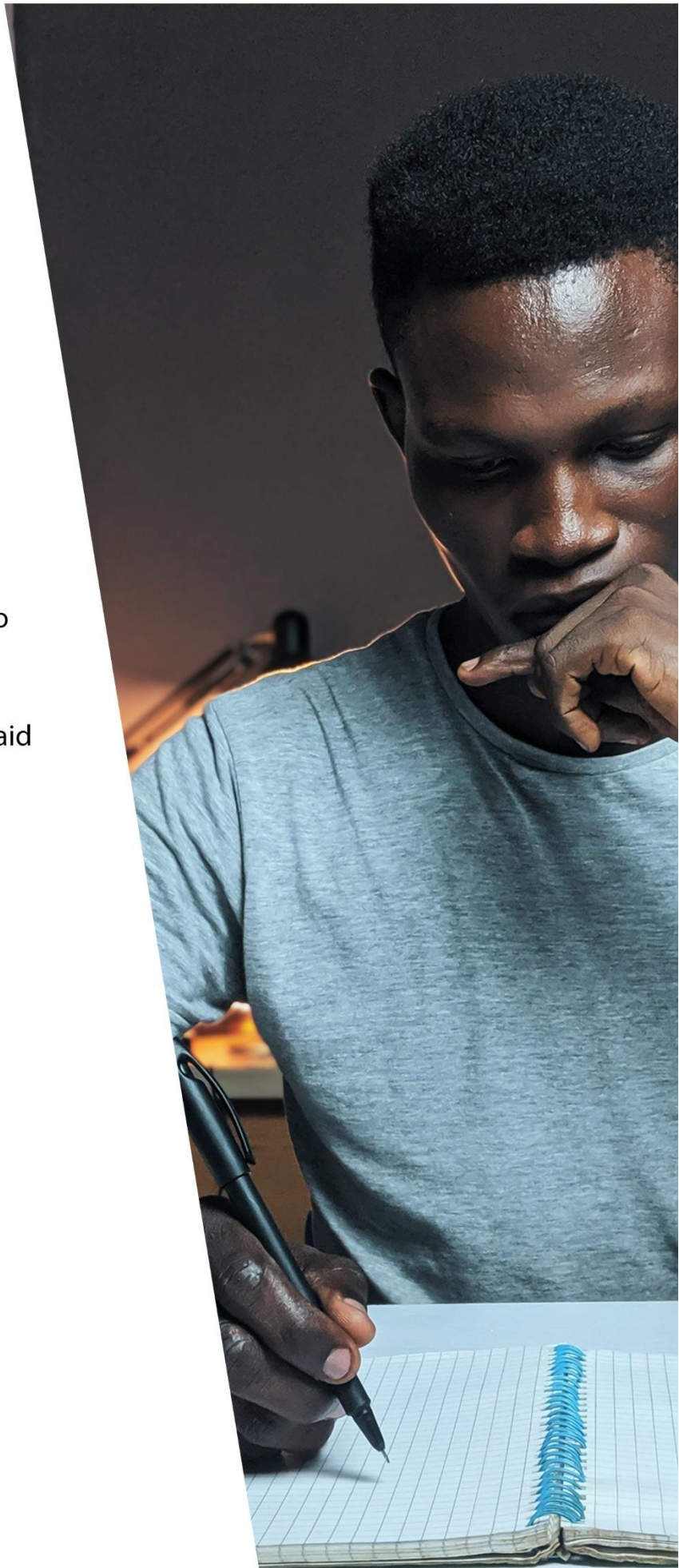
Scholarships ■
